When we tell a story, we should use time phrases to let the audience know when things happen, e.g. **Once upon a time**, **Many years ago**, **After a few hours**, **After a while**, **Soon**, **Suddenly**, **All of a sudden**.

We can also use a variety of verbs (e.g. whispered) and adverbs (e.g. happily) to show how the characters speak, e.g.

'Rosie!' **yelled** Kip.

'A magic wand!' he shouted **excitedly**.

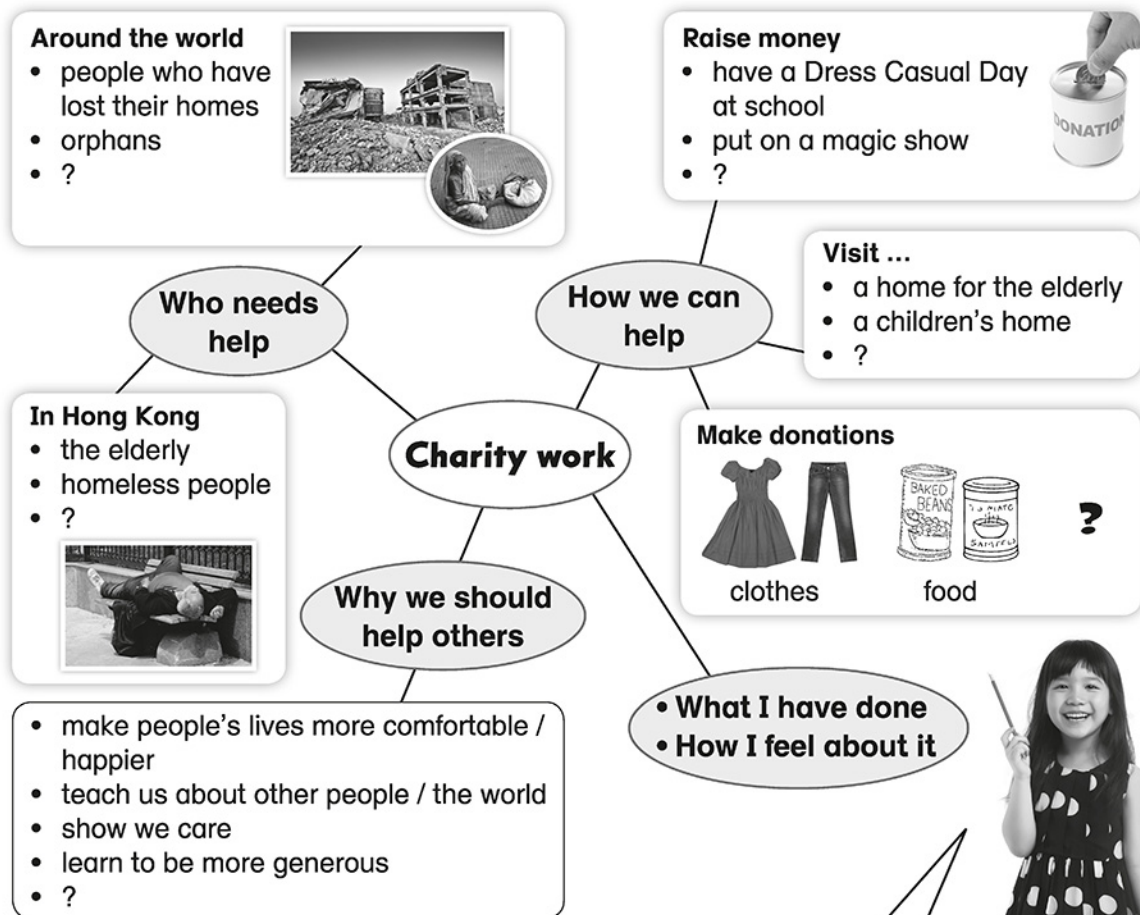
